The NTA announce a new NDTMS dataset to ensure it is reflective of the changes in the substance misuse sector. NDTMS CDS K will be effective from 1st April 2013 and implemented for the following reasons:

1. Drug reference data is updated with new substances clients are presenting with
2. Discharge reasons accurately reflecting successfully completed treatment programme for Residential Rehabilitation and inpatient services



What is CDS K?

Discharge Codes – Residential Providers Only

There are 4 new discharge codes for Residential Providers only:

1. 93 – Transferred – programme completed at the residential provider – additional residential treatment required
2. 94 – Transferred – programme completed at the residential provider – additional community treatment required
3. 95 – Transferred – programme not completed at the residential provider – additional residential treatment required
4. 96 – Transferred – programme not completed at the residential providers – additional community treatment required

Group 16: (Other drugs)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Pregabalin (Code: 8704)• Gabapentin (Code: 8705)• Areca nut (Betal, paan)(Code: 8706))
Group 17: Novel Psychoactive Substances	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• NPS – predominantly stimulant (Code: 8800)• NPS – predominantly hallucinogenic (Code: 8801)• NPS – predominantly dissociative (Code: 8802)• NPS – predominantly sedative or opioid – like (Code: 8803)• NPS – not otherwise specified (Code: 8805)
